



### **New SCU Academic Model**



- Students can enrol in a maximum of 2 units per term
- The standard full-time study load is 8 units over 4 terms per year
- Students submit 2-3 assessments per unit



Prominence is an indicator of the momentum or visibility of a given topic. While it does not indicate 'importance', it can indicate the likely level of global funding available. Publications are clustered into topics and topic clusters using direct citation analysis on Scopus publications. Citations counts, view counts and average CiteScore metrics are combined to yield prominence.
