RUN WELCOMES PROFESSOR SANDRA HARDING AS INCOMING CHAIR OF UNIVERSITIES AUSTRALIA

The Regional Universities Network has welcomed the announcement of Professor Sandra Harding, Vice-Chancellor of James Cook University, as Universities Australia's incoming Chair.
